If you have completed less than 24 quarter credits (16 semester credits) in college, include a copy of your High School / GED / High School Equivalency Program transcripts or test scores.

Tuition support for a student who is an Agriculture major with a 2.5 GPA average. Must be registered as a full time student and an active member of the AG Ambassadors Club. Awarded by the Agriculture Department.

Albertson Foundation Scholarship

Tuition support for Caldwell campus students. Criteria to be determined.

Larry Bean Memorial Scholarship

\$100 towards fall term tuition for an Athlete who participated in Track at Ontario High School. Awarded by the Athletic Department.

Earl Blackaby Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for Business majors. Must have a 3.0 GPA and enroll as a full-time student. Recipients demonstrate outstanding character and financial need. Renewable for a second year.

Mary Gail Blackaby Memorial Scholarship

Criteria same as the Earl Blackaby scholarship. Renewable for a second year.

Clara Ann Burdic Memorial Scholarship

Recipients must show financial need and academic achievement.

Loretta Cables Scholarship

Tuition support to a high school graduate residing within the TVCC service district. Based on financial need, academic achievement and outstanding character. Renewable for second year.

Capps Family Endowed Scholarship

Tuition support for a student from the local Oregon or Idaho area. Based on financial need and academic achievement. Renewable for second year.

Community Scholars (TVCC & Caldwell) Scholarship

Nominated by high school counselors and determined by TVCC Dean of Student Services & Caldwell Campus Director.

Lowell & Rosemary Cox Scholarship

Scholarships awarded based on academic potential, community service and financial need. Must maintain a 2.0 GPA and be enrolled for 12 credit hours. Renewable for second year.

Crosby Family Scholarship

Criteria to be determined.

Laura Moore Cunningham Foundation Scholarship

Scholarships for students from Idaho. Based on academic excellence, strong work ethic, leadership experience, a well-rounded personable character, financial need and a 3.0 GPA, which must be maintained. Renewable for a second year.

Opal Curry Dean Memorial Scholarship

Non-Traditional student (usually returning to education following an absence), studying an academic curriculum in Education, preferably Elementary Education.

Hilda D. Elliott Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for students majoring in Business, Accounting or Nursing. Renewable for a second year.

Epionce Sports Medicine Scholarship

Tuition support for an incoming Freshman (not necessarily right out of high school) majoring in Athletic Training. Must be from the Western Treasure Valley and have a 3.0 GPA.

Findley Family Scholarship

Criteria to be determined.

James & Harriett Flanagan Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for TVCC second year Nursing student. Must sign an agreement to work as a registered nurse for two years in the community following graduation.

Ralph & Jean Fountain Memorial Scholarship

Scholarships for Non-Traditional students from Malheur and/or Baker counties. Renewable for a second year.

Louis Gasca Memorial Scholarship

Award for student returning to TVCC for second year. Student must maintain a 3.0 GPA and receive the recommendation of department chairs.

James Gerke Honorary Scholarship

Awards for tuition support for students from the local Oregon or Idaho area, (family's preference is Idaho) majoring in Criminal Justice or other Law Enforcement related program. Based on academic achievement, financial need and community service. Renewable for second year as long as 2.5 GPA is maintained.

John & Betty Gray Early Childhood Education Scholarship

Tuition support to students majoring in Early Childhood Education.

Andrew "Bud" Greeley Natural Resources Scholarship

Tuition support for a student from Malheur Country for at least two years. Major in Soil Conservation or related agricultural or natural resources field such as Agronomy, Rangeland Resources or Ecology, Geology, Crop Management, Fish & Wildlife, Forestry, Agricultural Education or Engineering. Must maintain a 3.2 GPA.

Loran H. Halcom Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support to a student from the local Oregon or Idaho area. Based on academic achievement and financial need.

E.M. "Curly" & Clara Hauser Scholarship

Tuition support for a graduate from a Malheur County High School with a solid track record in 4-H or Future Farmers of America awarded by the Agriculture Department. Must have a high school GPA of 3.0. Renewable as long as 3.0 GPA is maintained.

Heart 'n Home Hospice Scholarship

Tuition support for a second year Nursing student showing promise of completing program with financial need. Must be a resident of hospice service areas.

Harold & Mika Hiuga Scholarship

Tuition support to a student of Diverse Cultural background. Must have financial need and academic achievement. Renewable for a second year.

Linda C. Huff Memorial Scholarship

Annual award to a student majoring in Law Enforcement or Criminal Justice.

Idaho Power Company Scholarship

Tuition support with emphasis on Minority students with financial need.

Instrumental Music Scholarship

Awarded to a Music major based on financial need & academic achievement. Awarded by Music Department.

International Business Education Studies Tour Scholarship

Must be at least a half-time student throughout academic year in which travel occurs and have a GPA of 2.75 or higher. Preference for Business majors with financial need.

Gertrude Johnson Memorial Scholarship

Awards for tuition support to students based on academic achievement and community service. Renewable for a second year.

William Kaatz Scholarship

Award based on financial need and academic potential. Student must have clear educational and career goals. Renewable for a second year.

Ed Manker Scholarship

Tuition support to a baseball athlete based on character. Awarded by the Athletic Department.

Joe & Betty Marquina / Dyer & Sadie Bennett Scholarship

Two awards for tuition support to a Malheur County high school graduate. Recipients must have educational goals and a financial need. Renewable for a second year.

George & Nellie Matsuura Scholarship

Awarded to a Music major based on financial need & academic achievement. Awarded by Music Department.

Catherine Mezzano Memorial Scholarship

Award for a student with academic potential and financial need. Renewable for a second year.

Bob McKinney Memorial Scholarship

Full tuition awarded to a student with minimum of 2.5 GPA planning on attending TVCC. Must complete an application with brief autobiography and have two letters of reference turned in to their high school counselor's office.

Miller Foundation Scholarship

Scholarship awards to students who are the first person in their family to attend college.

Sig & Mitsuko Murakami Scholarship

Tuition support for a student from an Agricultural families with demonstration of family's own support towards the educational goals of the student. Renewable for a second year.

Russell Myrick Memorial Scholarship

Award for a graduate from Nyssa or Ontario High School that is considered an "At Risk" student. Must complete high school & demonstrate necessary dedication to succeed on a college level, have financial need and involvement in Athl etics. Not Renewable.

Richard B. Nelson Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support to a student from the local Idaho area with preference given to students from Weiser. Based on academic potential, financial need and community service. Renewable for a second year.

Peggy Newton Memorial Scholarship

Scholarship will be awarded to a "second" year Nursing student from local Oregon and Idaho area. Must sign an agreement to work as an RN for one year in the community following graduation. Awarded by Nursing Department.

Shizuo & Frances Nishimura Scholarship

Scholarship support awarded to second year student from the local Oregon or Idaho area who has clear educational and career goals after graduating from TVCC. Not renewable.

Nyssa Volunteer Fire Department Scholarship

Tuition support awarded to a student from Oregon with preference to a student from Nyssa. Based on financial need, academic achievement. May be a recent high school graduate or Non-Traditional student. Not Renewable.

Sgt. John Ogburn III Memorial Scholarship

Two awards for one male and one female student from the Malheur, Payette or Washington County. Student must have a 3.0 GPA, financial need and active in extra-curricular activities and community service. Not renewable.

Ontario Kiwanis Club

Support for an Ontario High School graduate who had been a member of the OHS Leadership class, have community involvement, academic record & financial need.

Ontario Lions Club Dual Enrollment Scholarship

Ontario High School Junior or Senior -with enrollment in TVCC COL-CRED or Dual Enrollment Classes

Ontario Optimist Club Scholarship

Sophomore Athlete who completed their Freshman year at TVCC. Maintain a 3.0 GPA and must have graduated from a high school within the TVCC taxing district.

Ontario Women's Club Endowment

Scholarships awarded to students majoring in Business, Literature, Music, Agriculture, Nursing, Social Science, Drama and Art. Awarded in order of discipline shown.

Oregon Association Chiefs of Police Scholarship

Awarded by the Oregon Association of Chiefs of Police.

Oregon Sheriffs Association & Ron Mallea Memorial Scholarship

Recipients are required to enroll as full-time student, maintain at least a 2.0 GPA and major in Criminal Justice. Awarded by the Ontario retired Chief of Police.

PEO - Chapter AF Scholarship

Tuition support for a Female or GED graduate from a local Oregon or Idaho high school. Must be a full or part time student with good character, have academic achievement, community involvement and financial need. Awarded by the AF PEO Chapter. May be renewable.

PEO - Chapter EB "Fritz" Mowrer Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support for a Female graduate from a Malheur County High School who has completed her first year at TVCC. Must be planning to transfer to four year college to complete education. Awarded by the EB PEO Chapter.

PEO - Chapter K Mildred Wood Memorial Scholarship

Tuition support awarded to a TVCC Non-Traditional Female student. Must have clear educational goals and have a financial need. May be renewable, eligible to re-apply.

Harry L. Peterson Scholarship

Tuition support for a TVCC Athlete recommended by the Athletic Director.

Betty Lou Powers Scholarship

Award for a student majoring in Music recommended by the Music Department. Clear educational and career goals with the potential to succeed at the college level. Renewable for a second year.

Tip Powers Scholarship

Award for a student majoring in Business. Clear educational and career goals with the potential to succeed at the college level. Renewable for a second year.

Rodeo Scholarship

Scholarship awarded to Rodeo student by Rodeo Department

Rotary Club of the Western Treasure Valley Scholarship

General scholarships for current year graduating high school seniors and single parents from Malheur, Payette or Washington counties based on community involvement and financial need. Recipients chosen by Rotary Club Scholarship committee.

Prudi Sherman Scholarship

Tuition support for TVCC students. Selection will be based on financial need, academic achievement.

Sterling Savings Bank Scholarship

Award to Business major student having a financial need. Must maintain 2.5 GPA.

Stoneberg Boenig Scholarship

Award for a Nursing student from Malheur County. Awarded by Nursing Department.

Wayne Takami Memorial Scholarship

Award to a Fine or Applied Arts major who demonstrates financial need. A 3.0 GPA must be maintained and student must be full time. Not renewable for second year.

Dr. Benjamin & Mrs. Michiye Tanaka Scholarship

Tuition support for TVCC students. Renewable for second year.

Dr. Robert Thornfeldt "20" Memorial Scholarship

Second year Nursing student, financial need, graduated from high school in either Baker, Canyon, Malheur, Payette, or Washington counties. Recipient must agree to work in the community as a RN for one year. Awarded by the Nursing Department & Thornfeldt Family. Must sign an agreement to work as an RN for one year in the community following graduation.

Karen Tipton Memorial Scholarship

Non-Traditional student (usually someone who is returning to school after an absence). Preference given to female students. Renewable for second year.

Hallie Urquhart Memorial Scholarship

Awards for entering Freshman students with minimum high school GPA of 2.0, who attended high school in Malheur, Grant or Harney County. Must be civic minded and have demonstrated interest and be involved in their community and have a financial need. Renewable for second year as long as 3.0 GPA is maintained.

Valley Family Health Care Foundation Scholarship in Memory of Linda Morgan

Student accepted into the Nursing program with a financial need. Must be a resident of Malheur, Payette, Gem or Washington Counties and show promise of completing the Nursing program and a subsequent successful Nursing career.

William Van Atta Memorial Scholarship

Non-Traditional student from Malheur County (usually returning to education following an absence) with demonstrated potential and financial need.

Kango & Nobue Wada Scholarship

Tuition support for TVCC students. Renewable for second year.

Drex and Irene Williams Scholarship

Award for a student from the Rural Malheur or Harney counties with preference given to students from the Juntura or the Drewsey-Pine Creek School Districts. Must have at least a 3.0 average to qualify for award. Renewable for second year.

Ben & Laurine Wrenn Memorial Scholarship

Award by the President of TVCC to a TVCC graduating Sophomore who is transferring to a four-year program. Have high academic achievement and be of good character.
